Downgraded from "SET to READY"**

Coconino County, AZ — The Coconino County Sheriff's Office is pleased to announce the areas of Kachina Village, Forest Highlands, and Pine Del will be downgraded from "SET" (Pre-evacuation) to "READY" status. The zones for these areas are 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 96, 97, 98, and 99.

The decision to downgrade to "SET" status was made in conjunction with the Forest Service's Critical Incident Management Team. While conditions have improved to allow this adjustment, residents will continue to see smoke and fire activity for the foreseeable future.
