To meet the current demand for COVID-19 testing, Somerset and Morris County have opened up multiple testing sites:

Somerset County Department of Health has opened up pop-up testing sites including rapid and PCR testing at the Emergency Services Training Academy in Hillsborough twice a week and PCR testing only in Montgomery weekdays 8am-3pm. See below for our upcoming <u>vaccine clinics</u>. All vaccine clinics will be from 3-5 pm at Saint James Church, 184 South Finley Ave, Basking Ridge, NJ:

Pediatric Pfizer (5-11) - Monday, Jan 31st

1st and 2nd doses available

Pfizer (12+) - Tuesday, Jan 18th

Primary series for 12 + (1st and 2nd doses) and boosters for 12+

Moderna and J&J - Wednesday, Jan 19th

Moderna primary series or boosters and J&J primary dose or boosters for 18+

For all clinics:

- If you are symptomatic, or waiting on the results of a COVID-19 test PLEASE RESCHEDULE.
- If you are **quarantined due to an exposure** to a positive case (including household) please get tested on day 5 from last exposure and attend only after testing negative.
- If you have **recently tested positive** for COVID-19, please consult your healthcare provider before getting a COVID-19 vaccine. For the safety of all participants, please wait until **after day 10** of your positive test and **after your symptoms resolve** to attend our clinic.
- Walk in appointments may be available but are not guaranteed.
- Bring your original vaccine card with you if you're coming for a second or booster dose. If you only have a picture or Docket, you will be given a second card.
- No ID or insurance required for COVID-19 vaccines.
- Please wear a well-fitted mask and social distance.

Updated K-12 Schools Guidance

The NJDOH has updated its <u>"COVID-19 Public Health</u>

Recommendations for Local Health Departments for K-12

Schools". NJDOH is aligning with CDC's recommendations for shortened quarantine and isolation time frames. Check with your school district for specific guidelines.

CDC is currently updating guidance for other specific settings including childcare and higher education to consider how isolation and quarantine should be applied in these settings. NJDOH will review and update guidance once the CDC guidance is released.
