• All heavy rain has exited the area, with Tropical Storm Francine, positioned at the 4AM advisory crossing into southern Mississippi, continuing to the northeast at 12

Gusty winds remain across a large portion of the area, ranging 20-40mph but will

Residual flooding remains a concern, specifically for areas that saw significant

Lingering coastal flooding will continue to be a concern as well, as it will take some










## 4:00AM Update









## Storm Total Rainfall




## Wind Watches and Warnings

### **Tropical Storm Francine**



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
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Occasional gusts to tropical storm force will be possible early this morning, likely diminishing some going into the rest of the day (but still remaining breezy).







### Last Updated: 9/12/2024 4:50 AM

- Hazards Flood Watch
- A Flood Watch remains in effect for all of SE LA and southern MS early this morning to 7AM.
- This is due to residual/lingering flooding from widespread heavy rain yesterday into last night.








## Storm Surge Warning

### **Tropical Storm Francine**



## Last Updated: 9/12/2024 4:50 AM

Storm surge warning remains in effect for coastal areas east of Grand Isle to the AL/MS line, including the tidal lakes/sounds.

This is due to ongoing surge/tidal inundation that may be slow to recede after this morning.










## **Ongoing Storm Surge Forecast**

Coastal flooding continues early this morning during peak high-tide cycle.

Tides/waters will be slow to recede, as it will take some time for northwest to westerly winds to pull water out of lakes/sounds into the Gulf.












## **River Crest Forecasts**

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## Hurricane Preparedness **Use Caution After Storms**
