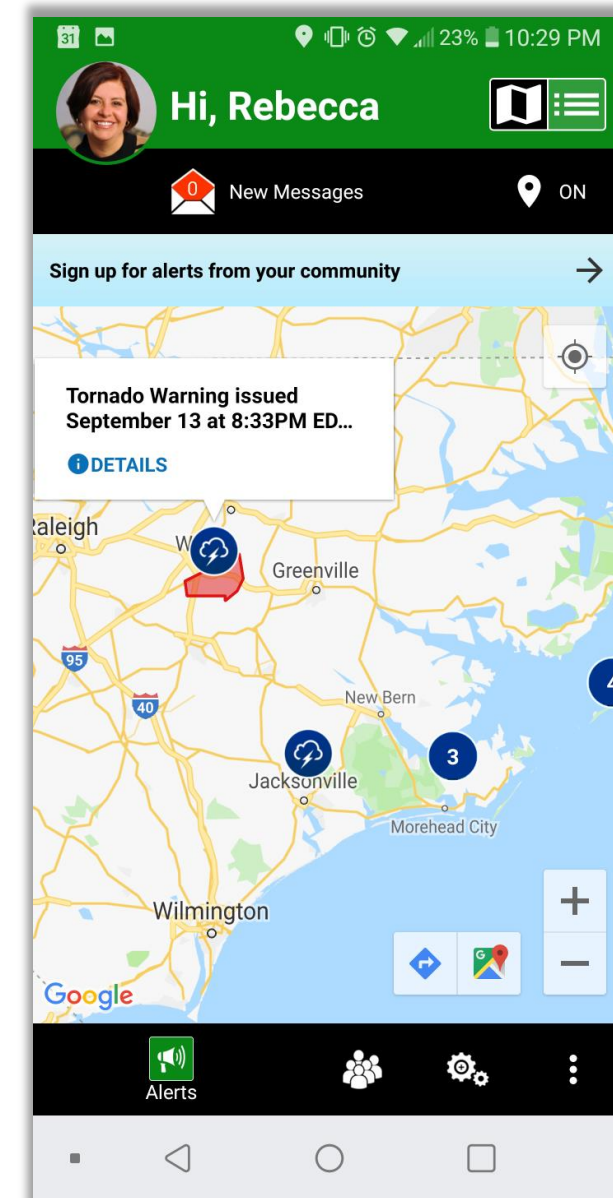




# AUTOMATED SEVERE WEATHER ALERTS
