TIMELY WARNING

Lewd Conduct

On Wednesday, February 18, 2026, at 4:55 P.M. OCC Campus Public Safety was notified of an indecent exposure in parking lot H, south of the softball field. At 4:50 P.M. the victim was parked in a parking stall, when the suspect vehicle described as a newer model BMW, four-door, dark grey, with tinted windows, parked in the next parking stall. The suspect rolled down his window, exposed himself and performed a lewd act. The suspect was described only as a male. The victim fled the area in their vehicle and contacted OCC Campus Public Safety.

Safety Tips:

- If you feel you may be in danger, immediately go to a safe location and report the crime to law enforcement.
- Be a good witness: It is important to recall what you observed and provide as many details as possible to law enforcement such as: sex, race, age, height, hair color, clothing, tattoos, scars of any suspects and a description of the make and model of any vehicle used in the crime and its license plate if possible.
- Dial 9-1-1 for emergency or in-progress events. Non-emergency call 714-432-5017.
- Do not attempt to apprehend any suspects or perpetrators of crime. Your personal safety and the safety of others around you should be your primary concern.

These Timely Warnings provide information about campus safety situations and allow campus community members to take precautions for personal safety.
