## **TIMELY WARNING**

### **Hate Incident**

On Thursday, February 12, 2026, OCC Campus Safety received a report of a hate incident. A student reported that they parked their vehicle in the G Lot, north of the Harbour Apartments, on Saturday, February 7<sup>th</sup>, 2026, at approximately 9:00 PM. The following morning, on Sunday, February 8<sup>th</sup>, at around 9:00 AM, the student discovered a racial slur written on the rear window of their vehicle.

OCC is committed to fostering a safe and inclusive environment for all members of our community. If you see something, say something. We encourage anyone with information about this incident to contact Campus Safety.

### **Safety Tips**

- Contact the Costa Mesa Police Department (714) 245 -5252 or OCC Campus Safety at (714) 432-5017.
- Get medical attention (if you need it).
- Write down the exact words that were said or take photographs of the words written.
- Make notes about any other facts so you don't forget them.
- Save all evidence (graffiti, writing on victim's vehicle). If safe, wait until law enforcement arrives and takes photos.
- Get the names, addresses, phone numbers, and emails of other victims and witnesses.
- Try to get a description from any eyewitnesses of the suspect (s) or the vehicle.

OCC Timely Warnings are released by the Campus Public Safety office when certain crimes are reported on or near OCC property, in compliance with federal law. These Timely Warnings provide information about campus safety situations and allow campus community members to take precautions for personal safety.
